EXTREME TEMPERATURES POLICY

1. BACKGROUND

This Policy is required to ensure the Club exhibits a “duty of care” towards Members and is to be enforced In the event that the temperature recorded on the thermometer outside the Clubhouse is in excess of 38°C

2. POLICY

In the event that the temperature recorded on the thermometer outside the Clubhouse is in excess of 38°C, the following will apply: -

- 2.1 The Competition of the Day will be terminated and all players entered, who have not completed their round, will be entitled to a refund of their competition fee. The Match Committee will determine whether or not sufficient players have completed their rounds to constitute a Competition. If so, prizes will be allocated in proportion to the number of players in the Competition.
- 2.2 The Board of Management **recommends** Members and visitors do not play under conditions of extreme temperature. Members and visitors, who do continue to play, do so at their own risk. Those players who commenced their round prior to the temperature reaching 38°C, and who continue at their own risk, will still be eligible for inclusion in the Competition of the Day.
- 2.3 Ride on buggies will not be permitted on the course after 1pm on any day that the forecasted temperature is in excess of 39°C as broadcasted on the Channel 9 6.00pm news the day prior (and available on the club website).
- 2.4 Greens may be watered on a rotational basis during the course of play.
